

Eligibility

Only those students that have been admitted to FSU for Summer or Fall 2015 are eligible to complete this contract.

Steps to Complete Contract

Your contract will not be considered complete until you complete all of the following in this order.

- 1. Submit the online portion of the contract. (This is the first page of that contract.)
- 2. Complete 1 of these 2 items:
- Within 10 calendar days, pay the \$225 advance payment, OR
- If the second page of this contract and the contract status check indicate that you have an additional semester of Florida Prepaid Housing/Dormitory plan available, the Prepaid Housing plan will be billed for your deposit.
- If you are under 18 years of age at the time you submit this contract, you need to complete and return a Fall/Spring Parent Signature form within 10 calendar days of submitting your contract.

Contract Terms

The following are highlights of the terms and conditions of the Fall 2015/Spring 2016 housing contract:

- This contract creates a financial obligation for Fall 2015 and Spring 2016.
- This contract is binding regardless of room assignment.
- This contract cannot be cancelled for Fall 2015 unless you provide written notice to the Housing office that you will
 not be attending Florids State University for Fall 2015. If notice is provided by May 1, 2015 and you made a
 prepayment, you will be refunded your prepayment less a \$50 cancellation fee.
- This contract cannot be cancelled for Spring 2016 unless you provide written notice to the Housing office no later than December 1, 2015 that you:
 - · will not be attending Florida State University for Spring 2016, OR
 - are studying abroad for Spring 2016
- This contract requires that you secure a meal plan through Seminole Dining if you are assigned to or select a room in Bryan, Landis, Gillchrist, Broward, Reynolds, Jennie Murphree, or Cawthon Halls.

The full **Housing Contract Terms and Conditions** are available on our website. They will be shown and must be agreed to on the final page of this contract.

Roommate Requests

Students should complete their housing contract as soon as possible. Students with completed contracts will be able to submit a roommate request between February 18 through May 1, provided that both parties have submitted a housing contract.

Once a priority number is established (after you complete this contract), you will not lose your priority number if you request a roommate. However, if you mutually request a roommate, your roommate pair will be assigned based on the worst/highest priority number of the individuals in the pair.

Financial Aid

FLORIDA PREPAID HOUSING PLAN

(Fall/Spring only)

FINANCIAL AID

- Disbursed by 5th class day week before rent due
- Rent paid only after tuition & fees are paid in full
- Check balance after financial aid disburses
 - View & pay rent balance on/before rent due date
 - No balance invoice sent



Payments

PARTIAL PAYMENT

- Can be made at any point before the rent due date after student is assigned
- Encouraged for students whose financial aid will not pay rent in full OR to space payments out

LATE ASSIGNMENTS

• If assignment not made in 1st round, estimate that rent will be the suite-style double rate (\$3,275/semester)
