## **University Housing Informal Hearing Case Resolution**

## FINDING OF FACT:

## **<u>OUTCOMES(S)</u>**: (Responding Student is only responsible for selected sanctions)

**Conduct Probation** effective immediately and continuing through the end of \_\_\_\_\_\_. Conduct probation is defined as "a period of time during which any further violations of the *Student Conduct Code* may result in more serious sanctions being imposed."

**Disciplinary Probation** effective immediately and continuing through the end of \_\_\_\_\_\_\_. Disciplinary Probation is defined as "a period of time during which any further violation of the *Student Conduct Code* puts the student's status with the University in jeopardy. If the student is found responsible for another violation of the Code during the period of Disciplinary Probation, serious consideration will be given to imposing a sanction of Suspension, Dismissal, or Expulsion from the University."

You are to register and attend the **Smart Choices program offered by University Health Services.** Please visit <u>https://healthcompliance.fsu.edu/smartchoices/</u> to appropriately register for the program. The cost of the program is \$75 and will be billed to your student account. The program consists of **two sessions** and you **must attend both**. If you fail to attend one or both sessions after you have been scheduled you will be charged a \$25 rescheduling fee.

Complete the **Ethics workshop** by registering, paying the \$75 fee, and attending the workshop. The workshop consists of **two sessions** and you **must attend both**. The goal of the Student Rights and Responsibilities Ethics Workshop is to examine the process of ethical decision-making and a student's role in the Florida State University community. In order to do this, please register online at <u>https://dos.fsu.edu/srr/</u> for available dates and times. If you fail to attend one or both sessions after you have been scheduled, you will be charged a \$25 rescheduling fee.

You must complete \_\_\_\_\_\_ hours of **Community Service** with an on-campus office or service approved by University Housing. A signed letter or e-mail confirmation from your volunteer supervisor must be provided to <u>uh-</u><u>conduct@.fsu.edu</u> to confirm completion of the assigned community service hours.

You are required to pay \_\_\_\_\_\_ in **Restitution** to compensate the University for damages committed to its property. Restitution bills are placed on a student's financial account and are to be paid by the posted deadline.

You are to complete \_\_\_\_\_\_ Residence Hall Work Hours with the \_\_\_\_\_\_ Hall Facilities staff. Contact the Facility Supervisor of this hall to arrange the time for you to complete your work hours. Work hours are to be

You must complete a **FSU Policy Worksheet** review assignment. Please refer to the questionnaire provided to you via email to complete the sanction. Your answers must be written in complete sentences and submitted to <u>uh-conduct@fsu.edu</u> by the designated deadline.

You are to complete (a) **Reflective Essay(s)** on the following topic(s). Additional instructions will be provided to you via e-mail. You must submit you essay to <u>uh-conduct@fsu.edu</u> by the designated deadline.
