To search for an LLC class section in “Schedule Assistant” tab: Go to Schedule Assistant and use “Add Course” to select the subject (3-letter course prefix) and then the number (4 digits). Under the “Sections” gear, choose ONLY the specific section(s) from the list for your LLC in this appendix. Then add other courses and view your schedule options. Choose a schedule, then send to cart and register.

To search for all possible class sections for your LLC, use “Enrollment: Add Classes” tab: In the Student Group box, enter the 4-letter code for your LLC as noted in brackets. Select the section(s), add to cart, and then register.
